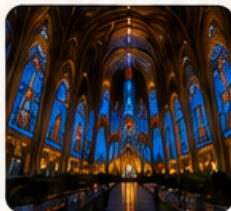

A masterpiece of Gothic Revival architecture. AURA immersive experience!



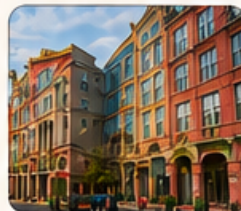
MOUNT ROYAL & KONDIARONK LOOKOUT
